

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

We will be learning to...

- Build constructive and respectful relationships
- Express our feelings and consider the feelings of others
- Identify and moderate our own feelings socially and emotionally
- Understand and use simple rules

### Physical Development

We will be learning to...

- Refine the movement skills acquired so far- develop our body strength, co-ordination, balance and agility
- create sequences of movement through partnering and artistry
- develop our small motor skills to enable us to use tools such as pencils competently
- Use our core muscle strength to achieve a good posture when sitting at a table

### Communication and Language

We will be learning to ...

- Ask questions to find out more
- Use new vocabulary in different contexts
- Articulate our ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences
- Describe events in some detail
- Engage in story times
- Listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding
- Engage in non-fiction books

### Mathematics

We will be learning to...

- Count objects, actions and sounds
- Subitise small amounts of objects to find familiar patterns
- Link numerals to cardinal number values
- Explore the composition of numbers to 10
- Recall number bonds for numbers 0-5 and some to 10
- Double numbers to 8
- Combine 2 groups (addition)
- Compare weight, height, mass and capacity
- Talk about and sequence time

### Pride Values

Our Pride Value this term is: **Independence**.  
Our definition of independence: Understanding that learning can be challenging and that failure is a valuable part of the process. Independent learners embrace mistakes as opportunities to grow.

We will be learning to...

- Read a few common exception words
- Read simple phrases and sentences
- Form lower case letters correctly
