Be aware, that some of these activities may contain things that you have been teaching at home but have not been covered at school.

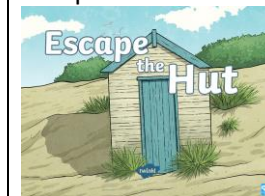

The Moji Road Trip Mystery



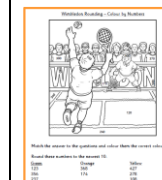
