Geography **Global Perspective**

- How do you use a map? What are the continents and oceans of the world?

Art and Design **Art from around the World**

- Can you create a picture or 3D sculpture using recycled materials?
- Research aboriginal art and create your own painting using cotton buds and paint, finger painting or drawing dots with felt tip pens.
- Investigate Japanese art and create your own landscape.
- Research famous artists and create a painting in the style of their artwork e.g. Claude Monet, Andy Warhol, Rene Magritte, Salvador Dalí, Yayoi Kusama.
- Can you make a sculpture or picture using only natural materials?

Science: Changing State

 - What affects how well a sugar dissolves? What does dissolve mean?
 - What are the best conditions for dissolving sugar in the fastest time?
