English

This term in English we will be exploring the traditional tales of Rapunzel and Cinderella.

In our writing we will be focussing on:

- Writing sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops correctly.
- Using adjectives for description
- Writing an alternative fairy-tale ending

Geography
