

English

This term our English is inspired by the Traveller tale 'Ossiri and the Bala Mengro'. Our grammar focus will be to write adverbial phrases of manner, time and place within simple and compound sentences. We will also identify and write adverbs that modify adjectives.

History

Romans

In our History lesson we will be answering these following questions:

- What was Britain like before the roman invasion and why did they invade?
- How did Boudicca effect Britain?
- How did the Roman invasion effect Britain?
- How did the Romans influence Britain today?

Music
