Healthy and balanced diet

This term we will be looking at what makes a balanced diet and how we can keep ourselves healthy.

French

Fractions

- Fractions on a number line.
- Fractions of an amount.

- Know how many hours are in a day
- Know how many months are in a year.
- Find the duration of an event.

This term in computing the children will:

Select, use and combine a variety of software (including internet services) on a range of digital devices to design and create a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals, including collecting, analysing, evaluating and presenting data and information

Religious Education

This term we will be studying Islamic art and symbols. We will be looking at the key questions:
