The Queen's Nose by Dick King-Smith

This term we will be reading the story 'The Queen's Nose'. We will be writing newspaper reports and learning:

- How to use speech marks and correct punctuation for direct speech.
- How to identify parts of a sentence and using these skills to write compound and complex sentences correctly.
- The features of newspaper reports.

History

By answering the question 'What was life like for the people in the ancient civilisations?' the children will develop their:

- Historical enquiry skills, by looking at images of artefacts from these civilizations.
- Ability to identify changes within and between different civilizations.
- Skills in make comparisons between elements of ancient civilizations.
