Learn how fronted adverbials are constructed and punctuated, spot them in our texts and write out own .

Write narratives using all our grammar features based on Ice Palace

Geography

By answering the question 'Why are rivers important and how do humans influence them?' the children will develop their:

- Geographical skills of investigating places, space and place and communicating in geography.
- Knowledge of river features.
- Knowledge of the importance of the River Nile, River Amazon and River Thames.
- Knowledge of human and physical features along a river.
- Use of 4-figure grid references.
- Knowledge of flooding and river pollution.

<u>P.E.</u>

This term the children will be learning coordination, balance and footwork, improving their skills of:


- Balance with matching pairing/mirroring

Computing

 This term children will be learning to Code. Their learning will focus on:

Using a background and objects to create a scene.
Planning an algorithm for their scene.

The children will also explore computer aided design during their DT unit about biscuits.
