### **The Day War Came by Nicola Davies**

By reading this powerful picture book, telling the journey of a child forced to become a refugee when war destroys everything she has ever known, we will be:

- Learning about the features of persuasive writing, then using what we have learned to argue persuasively in the form of a letter.
- Looking at how conjunctions and adverbials can be used to structure a piece of writing as part of a flashback story.

## Geography

By answering the question '**What influences the movement of people around the world?**' the children will develop their:

- Understanding of what migration is, and why people often leave to leave their homes either by choice or without.
- Knowledge of the different types of migrant, including economic migrants and refugees.
- Awareness of how climate change has impacted on migration with a growth in climate refugees.

## P.E.

### Creative skills

This term the children will be:

- Developing their flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through gymnastics.
- Developing their partner work and creation of sequences.

## DT

This term we will be making toy that move using cams. The children will:

- Understand that mechanical systems have an input, process and an output.
- Understand how cams can be used to produce different types of movement and change the direction of movement
- Know and use technical vocabulary relevant to the project, including: follower, axle, rotation, system

## Maths

### **Fractions, Decimals and Percentages**

- Ordering and comparing fractions
- Adding and subtracting fractions
- Multiply fractions

## Computing
