




## PANTS

## Safe touches

#### Safe touches can be:


- Cuddles and kisses from people we love and trust.
- A hug
- A high five
- A handshake

Sometimes someone might have to touch you in a way you don't like but it might be for a good reason. If you had fallen over and hurt your knee someone will have to clean it and put on a plaster.

It can hurt but we know it is for the best!

An adult might say 'I know this might hurt but we need to get your knee clean'
